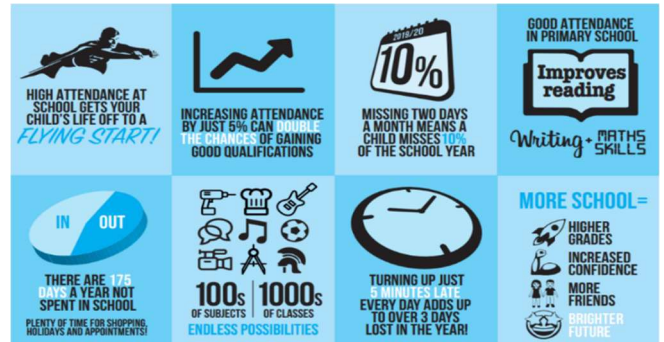

Power for Good anti-bullying week campaign 2025

In this morning's assembly the children were introduced to this year's theme, Power for good.

We will be focussing on a number of key concepts:

- A greater awareness of our trauma informed practices and therapeutic approaches to deal with varying degrees of behaviour (please see our behaviour policy for more detail).
- the children's understanding of what bullying is – STOP – Several Times On Purpose .
- the difference between a fallout between friends and behaviour which would be seen as bullying.
- introducing our Restorative practice Reps on the playground who will assist adults in helping children to mend broken friendships and resolve situations in a peaceful way using kind language and actions
- how we can show kindness to everyone at our inclusive school, develop our listening skills and show respect to all of our school family members at all times.
- The introduction of our weekly Fair Play at St Teresa's award.

We will start our anti-bullying week campaign with 'odd socks day' on **Monday 10th November**.
