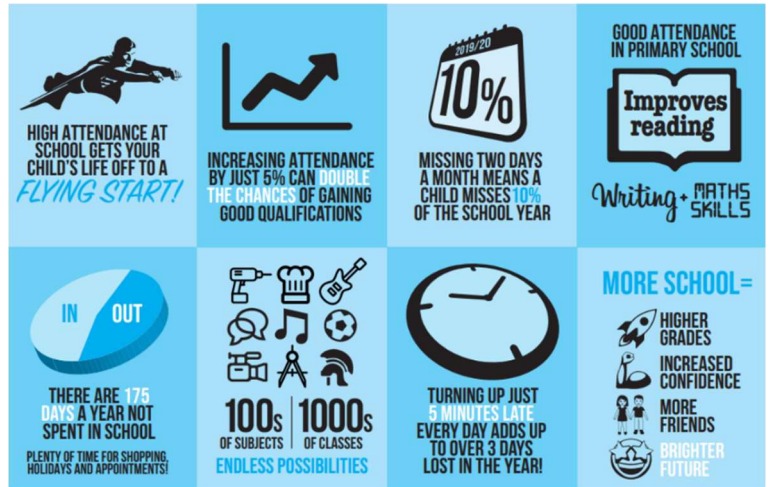
Congratulations to **Reception** for **PERFECT** attendance this week!!!
