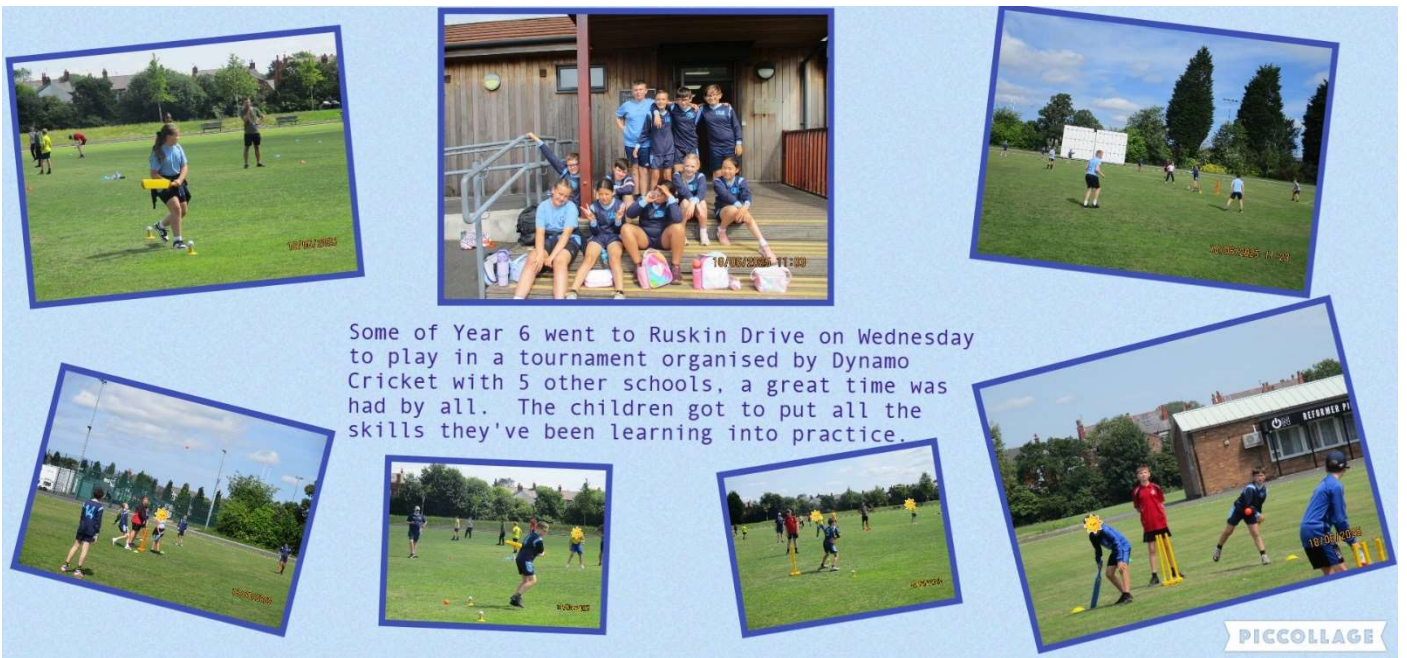


Garden Party Wednesday 16th July – in order to support our Garden Party we are having 2 non-uniform days:
