The NHS guidance for children with flu focuses on supportive care: rest, fluids, and fever relief with infant paracetamol or ibuprofen (never aspirin for under 16s). Encourage drinks like juice if not eating and honey for coughs (over 1 year old). For prevention, eligible children (2-3 years old, or in clinical risk groups) get the nasal spray or injection vaccine, while school-aged kids get it at school. If worried about severe symptoms or if your child is in a risk group, **contact your GP or NHS 111.**
