



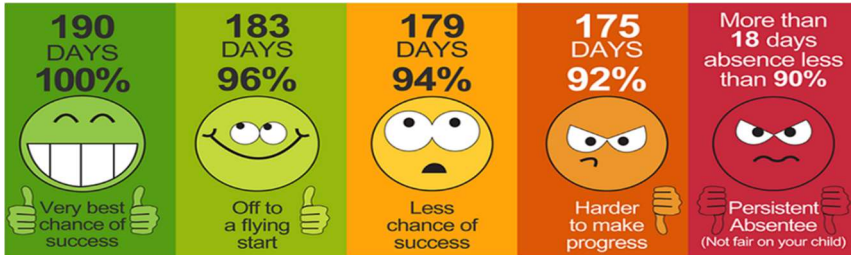

Safer internet Day – 11th February 2025 - learning will be based around the theme 'Too good to be true? Protecting yourself and others from scams online'

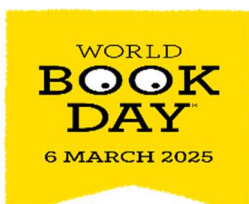
