## School Money (Eduspot) – Outstanding Monies

Please can all outstanding balances be cleared before the end of the school year.

Please see the below information from St Helens Council regarding term-time holidays.



St Helens Council prohibits term-time holidays except for exceptional circumstances, with fines of £160 per parent/child (reduced to £80 if paid quickly) for unauthorised absences of 10+ half-days. Parents must fill out a form to request leave.

### Penalty Notices (St Helens Council) [1]

- **First Offence:** £160 fine (reduces to £80 if paid within 21 days), per parent, per child.
- **Second Offence:** £160 (no reduction) within 3 years.
- **Third Offence:** Prosecution in Magistrates Court. [1, 2]

### Attendance Information [1]

- Family holidays are not considered "exceptional circumstances" and will not be authorised.
- Schools in St Helens are instructed not to authorise term-time absences for leisure.
