As the weather is changing and is much more wintery, please ensure your child brings a warm waterproof coat to school each day and additional hats, scarves, and gloves when appropriate.

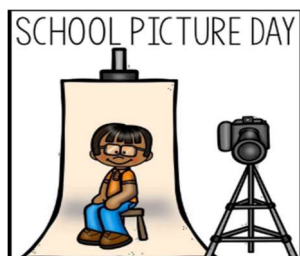
